PODIATRIC RADIOGRAPHY CERTIFICATE PROGRAM FOR UNLICENSED INDIVIDUALS FRIDAY. JANUARY 27

9:00am - 5:00pm

This 8-hour, practice enhancing course is designed to teach participants how to perform a podiatric radiology examination. Presented by New York College of Podiatric Medicine faculty, the class is a full-day hands-on workshop leading to a certificate in radiology. Emphasis will be placed on performing an accurate exam in a manner which is safe for both the patient and the examiner. Basic radiology principles will be reviewed with a special concentration on practical application. At the end of course, upon proving competency, the participant will be certified to take podiatric radiographs under the supervision of a licensed podiatrist and will receive an official certificate from NYSPMA.
